Section 73 – Application for removal of condition 5 (no cooking processes/hot food preparation on site) pursuant to 17/504389/FULL – Change of use of existing redundant post and sorting office to café and shop, including the demolition of existing outbuilding and erection of a single storey rear extension, rooflights to rear roof slope and alterations.
